

## CNFN Future Survey Walks.

**Recent walks have included** – the Arthur River Weekend in November where we enjoyed short walks to survey orchids and vegetation. The same weekend others enjoyed visiting the “Giants of the Leven Trail” at the Leven Canyon. In December the group did a field survey at Lemonthyme Forest. The January field survey in 2026 was at Bonds Plains in the Vale of Belvoir Conservation area, with sub-alpine grassland with rich plant diversity.
